on your knees before God, who made us!

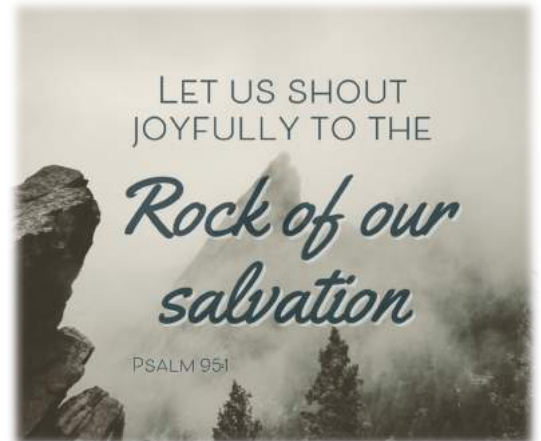
Oh yes, he's our God,

## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

### End of Term

Term 3 finishes for students tomorrow (Thursday). We will have separate K-2 and 3-6 closing chapels during the day and students will be dismissed from class at the usual time of 3:20pm. Friday is a student free day for parent-teacher reporting meetings.

### Parent-Teacher Reporting Meetings

Reporting meetings are being held in classrooms tomorrow afternoon/evening and on Friday morning.

- When coming to the school for meetings, please aim to arrive five minutes before your scheduled time and wait outside your child's classroom.
- If you are meeting with K-2 teachers, please be aware you will be in an area that is the registered space for OSHC use only. This means the K-2 playground, the undercover area outside the Years 1/2 classrooms, and the lawn area between the chapel and the canteen are for OSHC use only. Please use the veranda walkways to enter the K-2 classrooms.
- School aged children are welcome to sit outside the classroom (maybe bring a book to read) or play quietly in the senior quadrangle outside the Years 3-6 classrooms.
- Please follow COVID safe practices:
  - ◇ Stay home if you are unwell or have cold/flu symptoms (we can arrange a phone meeting or book another time for you to speak with the teacher)
  - ◇ Practise good hand hygiene – use the provided hand sanitiser when you enter the classroom
  - ◇ Practise physical distancing around the school and in classrooms.
